Instructor Pay	<ul> <li>\$750 per credit with a minimum of 10 paying students</li> <li>Agencies may choose to run courses with fewer than 10 in extenuating circumstances with administrative approval.</li> <li>Fees are adjusted for additional students:         <ul> <li>\$750 for up to 15 students</li> <li>\$900 for 16 - 20 students</li> <li>\$1050 for 21 - 25 students</li> <li>\$1200 for 26 - 30 students</li> <li>\$1350 for 31 - 35 students</li> </ul> </li> <li>At 36 students, program administrators will add a second instructor or run two courses.</li> <li>When instructors co-teach, they split the compensation for the course.</li> <li>When a course splits into two courses, instructors will be paid according to the number of students in their course.</li> <li>Graduate Credit Courses beginning after September 1, 2022: The instructor will receive an additional \$50 per credit per participant that registers for graduate credit. The graduate credit registration fee will be increased by \$50 per credit to cover this cost.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>\$750 per credit with a minimum of 10 paying students</li> <li>Slightly modified structure         <ul> <li>\$70/participant up to 9 students</li> <li>\$750 for 10 to 15 students</li> <li>\$900 for 16 - 20 students</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
