Instructor Pay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● \$750 per credit with a minimum of 10 paying students ● Agencies may choose to run courses with fewer than 10 in extenuating circumstances with administrative approval. ● Fees are adjusted for additional students: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ \$750 for up to 15 students ○ \$900 for 16 - 20 students ○ \$1050 for 21 - 25 students ○ \$1200 for 26 - 30 students ○ \$1350 for 31 - 35 students ● At 36 students, program administrators will add a second instructor or run two courses. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ When instructors co-teach, they split the compensation for the course. ○ When a course splits into two courses, instructors will be paid according to the number of students in their course. ● Graduate Credit Courses beginning after September 1, 2022: The instructor will receive an additional \$50 per credit per participant that registers for graduate credit. The graduate credit registration fee will be increased by \$50 per credit to cover this cost. 		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● \$750 per credit with a minimum of 10 paying students ● Slightly modified structure <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ \$70/participant up to 9 students ○ \$750 for 10 to 15 students ○ \$900 for 16 - 20 students
